Position Qualifications:

All candidates must meet *all* of the following minimum qualifications in order to be considered for the position:

General Requirements of Eligibility

- Must be at least (18) years of age.
- Must possess or be able to obtain a valid Colorado Driver's License with a good driving record and be insurable with the Mountain View Fire Protection District's insurance carrier
- Must meet *all* educational, certification and licensing requirements
- Must be of good moral character. Must successfully pass a personal and criminal background investigation.
- Must successfully pass an occupational physical, drug screen and any other applicable testing requirements deemed necessary by the fire district.

Education/Experience:

High school diploma or GED or Associate's Degree in related field

At least three (3) years' experience as a mechanic working with diesel and gasoline engines in a formal shop setting.

Equivalencies:

Associate's degree in automotive technology field plus one (1) year of the stated experience will meet the education and experience requirements.

License and certification requirements:

A valid Colorado Driver's License

ASE certification and EVT certification is desired, and required within 1 year of hire.

Other Requirements:

- Must supply own set of mechanic's hand tools.

- Members of the Mountain View Fire Board of Directors
- Any applicant who is unable to pass any portion of the selection or introductory process
- Any applicant who does not meet the minimum requirements for the position
